IMPORTANT DATES

Friday, October 9 - Regular Voter Registration Deadline

Voter registration forms must be postmarked or delivered to your county board of elections office by 5pm. Voters may also same-day register at any one-stop early voting site in their county from October 15 to October 31.

Thursday, October 15 - Start of One-Stop Early Voting

Voters may register and vote at any one-stop early voting location in their county of residence. For locations and hours, check with your county board of elections office, or vt.ncsbe.gov/OSSite.

Tuesday, October 27 - Deadline to Request an Absentee Ballot

Requests must be received by your county board of elections office by 5pm. Voters are encouraged to request and return their ballot as soon as possible.

Saturday, October 31 - One-Stop Early Voting Ends - One-Stop Early Voting Sites Close at 3pm

Tuesday, November 3 - ELECTION DAY

Absentee mail-in ballots must be postmarked on or before Election Day. Polls will be open from 6:30 am to 7:30pm for in-person voting. Locate your polling place at vt.ncsbe.gov/PPLkup

COVID-19 FREE TESTING - GOLDSBORO NEWS ARGUS (Printed Wed. 9/23/20)

Free COVID-19 tests are now being offered to the public at the Wayne County Health Dept. every Wednesday and Friday. The Tests will be performed from 9am to 1pm, weather permitting, at the dept, located at 301 N Herman St. Pre-registration is recommended to ensure an appointment time, but is not required. To register, call the health dept at (919) 731-1000 from 8am to 5pm Monday - Friday. Testing will be conducted in a drive-thru setting but walk up visitors or visitors who did not pre-register will be accepted. Any resident experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, close contacts of known positive cases, or anyone from a high risk population should be tested for COVID-19. Testing will be provided to the public regardless of insurance, and there will be no cost to the individual.
